Additional information relevant to the law, describing free access to information:

Number of requests filed by citizens, asking for information increased significantly, when compared with the last year. Most often, the filed requests asked for inspection results, mainly inspection results regarding fuel distributing gas stations.

Information provided by the CTI, in accordance with the free information access law, are published in electronic form on the CTI webpage and also in printed form on the central CTI billboard.

Questions or requests filed by citizens, institutions or by newspaper reporters and asking for the applicable information, or even requests that have not been filed according to the free information access law, are processed throughout the entire calendar year. Answers to these requests are offered free of charge, in accordance with free advisory services, or in cooperation with the state and public administration office or in cooperation with other institutions. These requests are not included into the request record keeping system, as described by the law mentioned above.
